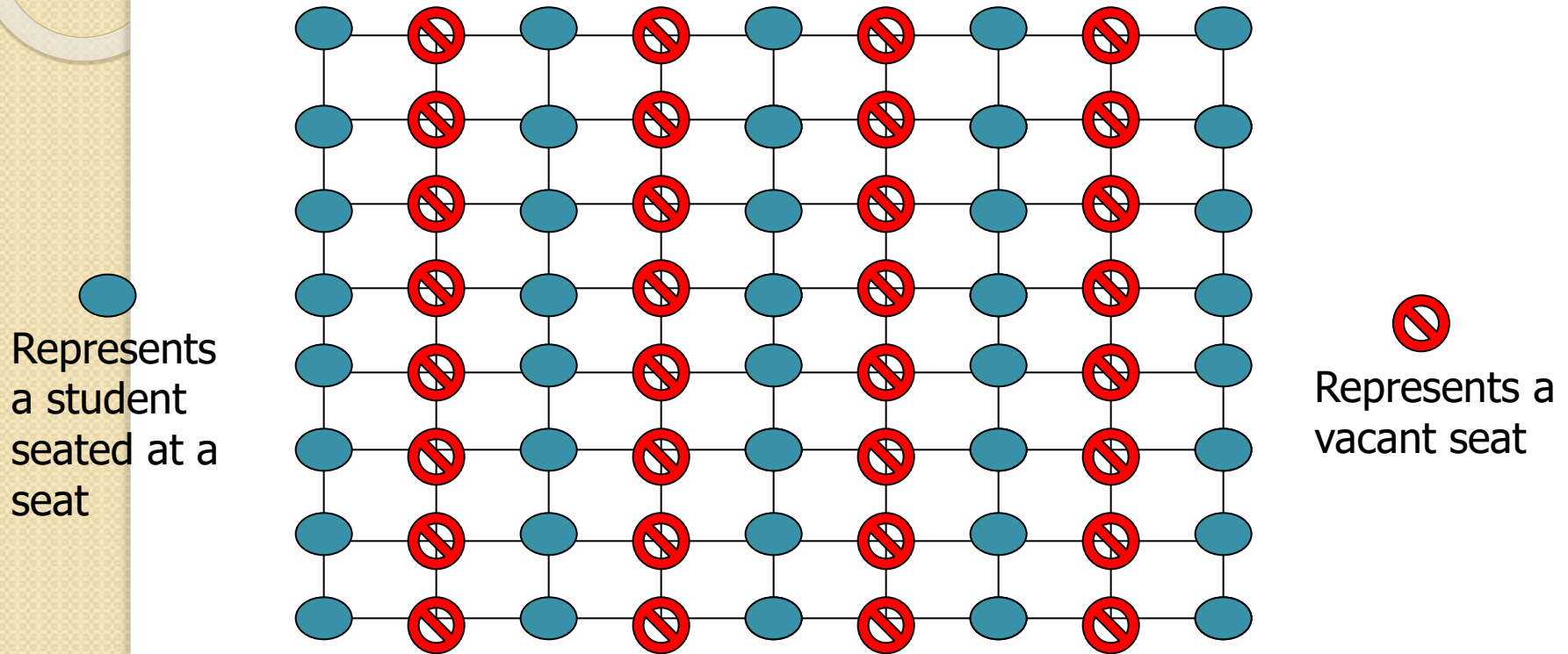
What to study?

 - For example:
 - Writing an algorithm and/or code
 - Writing an answer (in English)
 - etc...

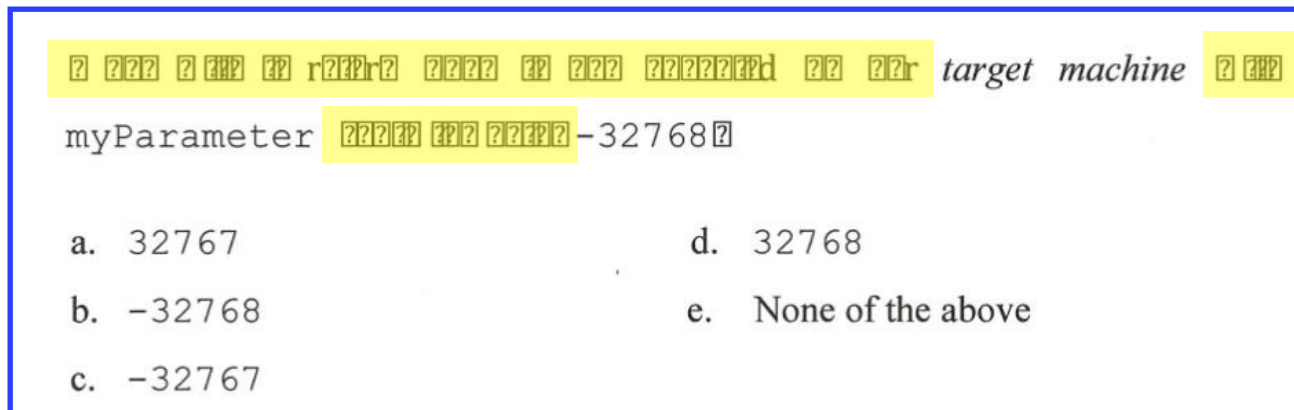
